TAXI DRIVER PROTECTION SCREEN

Driver protection screens are a mandatory purchase by taxi operators for every taxi in the metropolitan, outer suburban and urban taxi zones. This initiative will give drivers additional safety when working during the late night and early morning hours.

In country areas, taxi drivers are often more familiar with their customers so protection screens are optional in these taxis.

Vic roads



A protection screen is a partition which reduces the chance of a driver being attacked from behind by a passenger. Screens are made of clear polycarbonate, have different styles depending on the manufacturer and provide alternate means of providing driver/passenger separation.



The protection screen has to comply with the Australian Design Rules ADR3/03 where the basic parameters focuses on:

- The impact speed is between 48.3km/h and 50.4km/h
- The trolley deceleration corridor
- That the back seat is adjusted in normal seating position

At ASE we always follow the Australian Design Rules to make sure that all of our tested components are up to Australian standards.
